## **RULES & INFORMATION**

Make the most of your day with access to a splash pad, playground, basketball court, and tennis and pickleball courts! Whether you're stopping by for a quick visit or spending the afternoon outdoors, be sure to follow all posted rules to keep the park safe and enjoyable for everyone.

### **PARK RULES**

- 1.** An adult **MUST** accompany children under 12 years of age.
- 2.** Foul language, smoking, vaping, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park property.
- 3.** All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and are not permitted in play or splash areas.
- 4.** Please use park equipment as intended and share public spaces respectfully.
- 5.** This is **YOUR** park. Keep it clean.

*Public washrooms are open 8am to 8pm*

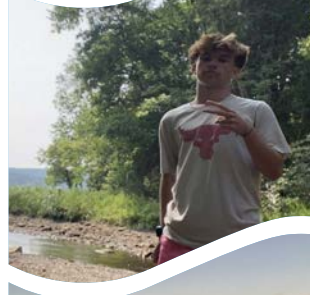

# RULES & INFORMATION

Join in the fun, splash in the sun, and take advantage of the sandy beach, natural playground and accessible boat and kayak launch! Be sure to understand all the rules in place to enjoy a safe, fun time at the park!

### PARK RULES

1. An adult **MUST** accompany children under 12 years of age.
2. The beach is supervised within the buoys. Anyone who swims outside of the marked area will be doing so at their own risk.
3. We strongly advise against swimming during thunder and lightning storms. Those who do will be doing so at their own risk.
4. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
5. Dogs are not permitted on the beach area.
6. Foul language and alcoholic beverages are not permitted on park property.

*Park Hours: 9:00am to dusk*

### SUPERVISED SWIMMING

The Department of Active Living and Culture is pleased to provide lifeguard supervision in the designated swimming area daily from 11:00am to 7:00pm. All lifeguards are NLS certified. This service will be offered from June 30 - August 27.

### SWIMMING LESSONS

Looking to learn how to swim? Free, casual swimming lessons will take place every Wednesday at Lillas Fawcett Park! Lessons will be run by our NLS certified lifeguards from July 2 - August 20. This program has two separate registrations for the July and August sessions.

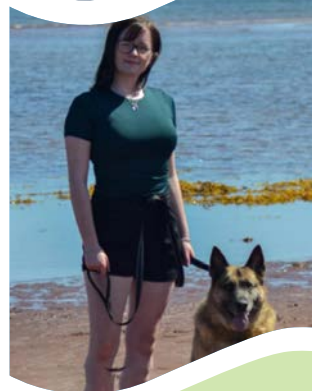

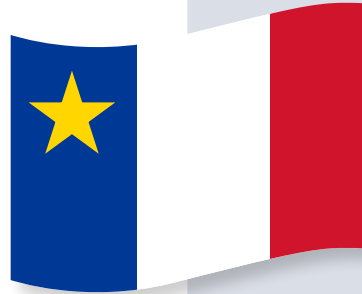
